### LOCAL MARKET UPDATE.

The **Kenya shilling** was largely unchanged against the dollar on matching demand and supply.

**Equity Market:** The NSE-20 share index rose by 15 points to close at 5,185.

**Fixed income Market/Money Market:** In the debt market, bonds worth Kes 0.692 billion were traded yesterday.

### GLOBAL MARKETS UPDATE.

**EUR:** The Euro fell to year lows against the green back after release of strong jobs data in the US.

**INR:** The Indian rupee fell against the dollar to sustained demand for the green back from corporates and importers.

**GBP:** The sterling took a hit against the dollar touching new lows on strong US non payrolls data.

**GOLD:** Gold fell on investor flight buying into the US dollar.

**CRUDE:** Crude fell as news came in on Saudi Arabia's price cut for January crude deliveries to the US.

**UGX:** The Ugandan shilling weakened further against the green back on sustained dollar demand from importers.
