**THIRD DAY: Read John 6:43-51.**

- b. What does God promise believers about death, and what is your response to His promises? (See John 6:44, 50-51; 11:25; and 1 Corinthians 15:54-55.)

**FOURTH DAY: Read John 6:51-59.**

*Note: The annual Passover feast formed the backdrop for Jesus' teaching in John 6. (See John 6:4.)*

8. What did the blood of the Passover lamb represent, and how did it protect the people from God's judgment? (See Exodus 12:1-30.)
  
9. For what was the lamb's flesh used, and how is this a picture of Jesus' promises to believers in John 6:52-59? (See Exodus 12:8, 11, 31, 39.)
  
10. List promises Jesus connected to "drinking," "eating" or feeding on Him. How do these promises help you understand His meaning, and how has your desire for this reality in your life increased?

**FIFTH DAY: Read John 6:60-71.**

11. Describe what it means that the Spirit gives life and the flesh counts for nothing. How have you experienced this in your life? (See John 6:63.)
  
12. Why did many of Jesus' disciples no longer follow Him? Has similar teaching ever offended you or others? Can you share with your group what happened?
  
13. How is Peter's commitment in verses 68-69 like the psalmist's in Psalm 73:20-28? How do these statements apply to you personally?

**SIXTH DAY: Review John 6:41-71.**

14. What have you learned about God in this week's study? How may your group pray for you as you make this truth a part of your life?
